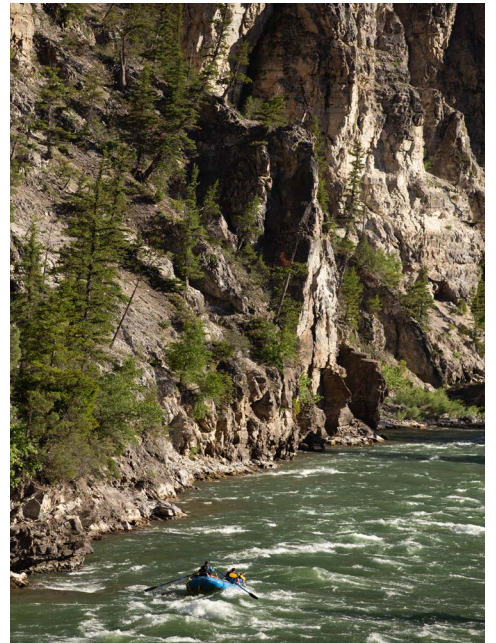
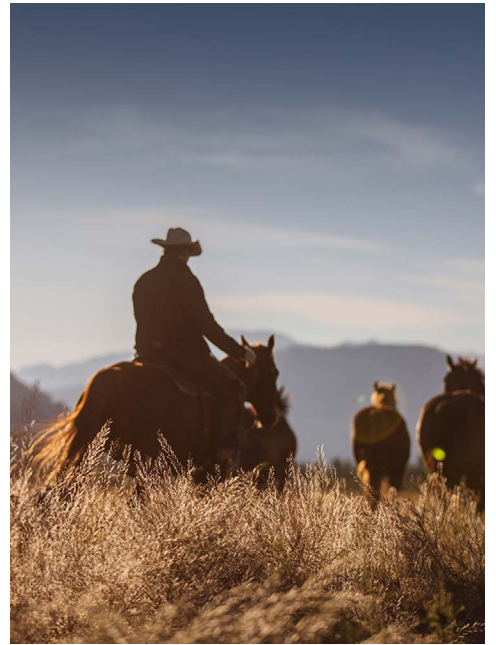

National Park Tours & Wildlife Safaris

Bison, elk, and moose... oh my! Take a tour on the wild side where our furry fauna friends roam through their Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem habitat. Your naturalist guide will provide insight into our wildlife, wild landscapes, and the park's history.

YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK TOURS

Yellowstone National Park is best explored with an experienced guide who will maximize your time in the expansive wilderness. Explore the park's highlights and points of interest, including geothermal activity of Old Faithful, geyser basins, thermal pools, and mud pots, as well as breathtaking views of waterfalls and the Grand Canyon of Yellowstone.

GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK WILDLIFE SAFARIS

Sunrise and sunset tours through the lower end of Grand Teton National Park and surrounding areas focus on wildlife sightings. Tours depart early in the morning or late in the day to optimize the wildlife's high activity periods.

Four-hour, door-to-door tours are a great way to fit in a wildlife excursion in a shorter period. While the 7 to 8-hour full day park tour offers everything in the half day experience plus lunch and more time exploring the area as well as options to hike some of the trails.

Wyoming's Wild Waters

Jackson Hole's famed Snake River offers thrilling whitewater rafting, leisurely scenic float trips, and blue-ribbon fly fishing. Plus, several other welcoming waters like Jackson Lake, Slide Lake, and the Gros Ventre River provide options to kayak, fish, SUP, and swim.

WHITEWATER RAFTING

Thrill seekers will enjoy the summer sun and refreshingly cool waters as your guide takes you on an exhilarating adventure down an 8-mile stretch of the Snake River Canyon with class II and III rapids.

Trips are available through the day from 8am to 4pm and each trip lasts 3-4 hours, starting from the boathouse in Jackson to the take-out area. Wet suits, splash shirts, and booties are available to rent.

SCENIC FLOAT TRIPS

Scenery seekers and shutterbugs will enjoy a leisurely float on the Snake River while watching for wild-life in their natural habitat along the riverbank.

Scenic float trips last about 3 hours and departure times vary within the season. The earliest trips begin at sunrise while the latest launches at 5:30pm. If spotting wildlife is your goal, we suggest an early or late float. You will need to arrive fifteen minutes early at the boathouse.

WOODEN BOAT TOURS

Enjoy an early morning or late afternoon fine dining experience on the Snake River in a vintage wooden boat. Sunrise and sunset are typically the best times to observe elk, moose, deer, beaver, river otters, osprey, and eagles.

Breakfast with Eagles

Departs from the Stilson Parking Lot at 7am for a 3–4 hour excursion. Your guide will have hot beverages and warm blankets available as you float. This stretch of the Snake River boasts some of the best bald eagle habitat. Once you arrive at the Tipi Camp nestled in a cottonwood forest, brunch begins with local baked goods.

Scenic Float & Dinner

Departs between 4 and 6pm for a 4–6 hour excursion. After a peaceful, luxury, scenic float trip, you arrive at Tipi Camp in time to enjoy the appetizers at the fire pit. Dinner is served in an open-air dining room serving premium cuts of the fish, beef, or wild game followed by dessert in a candlelit tipi.

FLY FISHING

Your visit to Jackson Hole offers access to some of the world's best trout fishing, including rainbow, lake, brown, and one of the last remaining populations of wild Snake River fine-spotted cutthroat. Whether you want to learn how to fish or you're a seasoned angler looking to try your fly on world-class waters, there's no better way to access the area's best fishing holes than with an experienced expert.

Full and half day guided trips include all fishing tackle, some include hotel transportation. Full day fishing lasts 6 to 8 hours while half days trips are 4 to 5 hours, leaving in the morning or afternoon.

JACKSON HOLE BIKE PARK

You'll stay at the base of Jackson Hole Mountain Resort offers easy access to the resort's Bike Park where options abound for every level, including novice trails as well as jaw-dropping advanced trails and jump tracks. Sail over tabletops, flow around corners, and then catch the Teewinot lift or Sweetwater Gondola for a 5 minute ride back to the top.

Hot Air Balloon Rides

Elevate your experience with sweeping views of the Teton Range as you soar at 2,500ft above the valley. Take in the landscapes of Jackson Hole Mountain Resort, Teton Village, and seven mountain ranges as well as the area's largest remaining private open space. You can sometimes spot moose or elk from up above.

One hour flights depart just after sunrise and include hotel transportation. Hotel pick-up is around 6am and you'll return roughly 3.5 hours later.
